Career Description



Salary & Outlook

As of 2018, software developers median pay was \$105,590 per year which is \$50.77 per hour. There are over 1,365,500 jobs available for software engineers (Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor).

The software engineer job outlook between 2018 and 2028 is a 21% growth which is much faster than average (Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Department of Labor). It is a necessary career given that current and emerging technology are expanding at an ever-increasing rate.
